

**Children's Sunday Assembly (CSA)**  
**A program of the Brooklyn Society for Ethical Culture (BSEC)**

**Registration, 2005-06 (revised Nov 10. 2005)**

**1. Cooperative agreement for 2005-06**

In order to create an effective program, each family is asked to pledge ten hours per year in the service of the BSEC Children's Sunday Assembly. In addition, we require that each family provide snack a few times a year. Please sign up on **Snack Calendar** by the sign-in book.

**2. Full year CSA Tuition**

Please read the Options A & B below to determine if you wish to enroll in CSA as a BSEC- Member-Family or simply as a CSA-Family. If you are interested in becoming a member of BSEC as you enroll in CSA, we ask that you please meet with BSEC Leader, Lisel Burns.

Payments can be made all at once, or in seasonal installments by arrangement.

If finances stand in the way of your CSA enrollment, please request tuition assistance.

If your finances allow, we welcome your contributions toward the building of a scholarship/outreach fund.

Please make all checks payable to the Brooklyn Society for Ethical Culture, and indicate "CSA Enrollment" in the memo field, indicating "BSEC membership" if relevant.

**Option A: CSA Enrollment without BSEC membership:**

1 child: \$550. 2 children: \$800. 3 or more children: \$1,000.

**Option B: CSA Enrollment with BSEC Family Membership:**

Pledges to BSEC are self-determined and inclusive of CSA tuition. (Please read further to determine the amount you will pay).

Your family pledge ranges between: \$500.00 and \$5,000.00.

The minimum fee of \$500.00 includes the basic \$400.00 BSEC pledge expectation and a \$100.00 fee to cover basic materials for CSA operations.

CSA families who choose (or who have chosen) to become BSEC MEMBERS, you are asked to consider this wide-ranging fee structure in determining your own pledge/payments, considering your holistic value for BSEC as a whole. While keeping in mind the overall finances of BSEC of which we are a program, we ask that you consider the operating costs of the program, as you respectfully honor your own financial ability to contribute. Of the money you contribute, \$200.00 is earmarked toward the American Ethical Union; the rest is earmarked for CSA/Family programs. BSEC families are welcome to take great initiatives in the functions and growth of the programs as well as in the fundraising endeavors that support BSEC and CSA. The cost of running our program is approximately \$500 per child.

**3. Schedule**

Make sure to have a CSA 2005-2006 schedule. Please integrate it into your family's calendar. If you know that your children will be absent on a particular Sunday, letting the director know in advance helps us to use our limited resources in the most careful way. Families are encouraged to attend all intergenerational platforms i.e. when CSA joins the rest of BSEC in the main Ethical Building. When CSA is closed, regular platform is still

available at BSEC and childcare can be made available if you wish to attend.
